Bacon-Jalapeno Grilled Cheese



- 1-1/2 tbsp. salted butter, soft
- 2 slices whole-grain bread
- 1/4 cup shredded pepper Jack cheese
- 1/4 cup shredded Cheddar cheese
- 1/4 cup shredded Monterey Jack cheese
- 2 slices bacon, crispy, halved crosswise
- 1/2 jalapeno, sliced into thin rounds

DIRECTIONS

1. Butter both sides of each bread slice. Place in a skillet over medium heat and brown.
2. Top one slice of bread with all three cheeses, the bacon halves, and jalapeno slices, and then the other piece of toast.
3. Reduce heat to medium-low and push down on the sandwich with a spatula to help melt the cheese. When the cheese is all melted, enjoy the melted cheese goodness!
